MINUTES OF THE PAYNE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD March 7, 2023

The Payne County Election Board met in a Regular meeting at 2:00 p.m. at the Election Board office located at 315 W. 6th, Suite 207 in Stillwater. A written notice was filed with the County Clerk on December 2, 2022, along with posting an agenda at the Election Board office on February 13, 2023. A copy of the agenda and notice are attached.

Walraven called the meeting to order at 2:08 p.m. with a quorum present.

BUSINESS CONDUCTED AT THE MEETING

- <u>BUSINESS CONDUCTED</u>: Discuss and approve minutes for the meeting held February 17, 2023. ACTION TAKEN: Klein moved to approve the minutes for the February 17, 2023 meeting, seconded by Andre. Roll call vote: Walraven aye, Andre aye, Klein aye. Motion passed 3-0.
