The Payne County Election Board met in a Special meeting at 3:00 p.m. at the Election Board office located at 315 W. 6<sup>th</sup>, Suite 207 in Stillwater. A written notice was filed with the County Clerk on December 8, 2023, along with posting an agenda at the Election Board office on March 5, 2024. A copy of the agenda and notice are attached.

### The following members were present:

Walraven called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. with a quorum present.

#### BUSINESS CONDUCTED AT THE MEETING

- 1. <u>BUSINESS CONDUCTED</u>: Discuss and approve minutes for the meeting held March 5, 2024. ACTION TAKEN: Callison moved to approve the minutes for the March 5, 2024 meeting, seconded by Bertholf. Roll call vote: Walraven aye, Bertholf aye, Callison aye. Motion passed 3-0.

ACTION TAKEN: Walraven move to recess until 5:00 p.m. Callison seconded. Roll call vote: Walraven – aye, Bertholf – aye, Callison – aye. Motion passed: 3-0. Meeting was recessed at 3:10 p.m. and reconvened at 4:55 p.m. in County Election Board office and called to order by Walraven with quorum present.
